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118 **Pre-Bid Conference.** The pre-bid conference for this project will be held on January 12, 2022 at  
119 2:00 p.m., in the City Council Chambers at Hurricane City, 147 North 870 West. An on-site visit at  
120 the Hurricane City Municipal Airport will follow the meeting. All bidders are required to examine the  
121 site to become familiar with all site conditions prior to submitting their bid.

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123 **Bid Conditions.** The bidder is required to provide all information as required within the Contract  
124 Documents. The bidder is required to bid on all items of every schedule or as otherwise detailed in  
125 the Instructions to Bidders.

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127 Bids may be held by Hurricane City for a period not to exceed 120 calendar days from the date of the  
128 bid opening for the purpose of evaluating bids prior to award of contract.

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130 The right is reserved, as Hurricane City may require, to reject any and all bids and to waive any  
131 informality in the bids received.

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137 **Bid Bond.** Guarantee will be required with each bid as a certified check on a solvent bank or a Bid  
138 Bond in the amount of five (5) % of the total amount of the bid, made payable to Hurricane City.

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140 **Performance & Payment Bond.** The successful bidder will be required to furnish separate  
141 performance and payment bonds each in an amount equal to 100% of the contract price.

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143 **Airport and Airway Improvement Act of 1982 as Amended.** In accordance with the Davis-Bacon  
144 Act, as amended, the Contractor will be required to comply with the wage and labor requirements and  
145 to pay minimum wages in accordance with the schedule of wage rates established by the United States  
146 Department of Labor.

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148 **Equal Employment Opportunity and Affirmative Action Requirement.** The proposed contract  
149 is under and subject to 41 CFR Part 60-4 and Executive Order 11246 of September 24, 1965, as  
150 amended, and to the equal opportunity clause and the Standard Federal Equal Employment  
151 Opportunity Construction Contract specifications including the goals and timetables for minority and  
152 female participation.

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154 **Title VI Solicitation Notice.** Hurricane City, in accordance with the provisions of Title VI of the  
155 Civil Rights Act of 1964 (78 Stat. 252, 42 USC §§ 2000d to 2000d-4) and the Regulations, hereby  
156 notifies all bidders or offerors that it will affirmatively ensure that any contract entered into pursuant

157 to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises will be afforded full and fair opportunity to  
158 submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race,  
159 color, or national origin in consideration for an award.

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161 **DBE Requirement.** The requirements of 49 CFR part 26 apply to this contract. It is the policy of  
162 Hurricane City to practice nondiscrimination based on race, color, sex, or national origin in the award  
163 or performance of this contract. The Owner encourages participation by all firms qualifying under  
164 this solicitation regardless of business size or ownership. The Hurricane City Municipal Airport has  
165 a DBE participation goal of 1.55% to be obtained through race/gender-neutral means.

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167 Contractor shall provide a certified statement signed by the subcontractors, indicating actual amounts  
168 paid to the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) subcontractors and/or suppliers that were used  
169 on the project through race neutral means.

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171 **Buy American Preference.** The Contractor agrees to comply with 49 USC § 50101, which provides  
172 that Federal funds may not be obligated unless all steel and manufactured goods used in AIP funded  
173 projects are produced in the United States, unless the Federal Aviation Administration has issued a  
174 waiver for the product; the product is listed as an Excepted Article, Material Or Supply in Federal  
175 Acquisition Regulation subpart 25.108; or is included in the FAA Nationwide Buy American Waivers  
176 Issued list.

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178 A bidder or offeror must complete and submit the Buy America certification included herein with  
179 their bid or offer. The Owner will reject as nonresponsive any bid or offer that does not include a  
180 completed Certificate of Buy American Compliance.

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182 **Certification of Offeror/Bidder Regarding Debarment.** By submitting a bid/proposal under this  
183 solicitation, the bidder or offeror certifies that neither it nor its principals are presently debarred or  
184 suspended by any Federal department or agency from participation in this transaction.
