

# INVITATION FOR BIDS

Sealed bids, subject to the conditions contained herein, for improvements to the Casper/Natrona County International Airport, Casper, Wyoming, AIP Project No. 3-56-0004-059-2019 and WYDOT Project No. ACP002A will be received by the Casper/Natrona County International Airport, Airport Director's Office, Casper, Wyoming, 82604, until Tuesday, June 18, 2019, at 1:00 P.M., and then publicly opened and read aloud.

The work involved will include the following:

Schedule I: Rehabilitate and Repair Apron, and Install Lighted "Do Not Enter" Signs for Abandoned Runway 17/35

Schedule II (Non-Federal): Rehabilitate and Repair Apron

**Pre-Bid Conference.** The pre-bid conference for this project will be held on June 4, 2019 at 1:00 P.M., in the Airport Board Room at the Casper/Natrona County International Airport, 8500 Airport Parkway, Casper, WY 82604. All bidders are required to examine the site to become familiar with all site conditions.

**Bid Conditions.** The bidder is required to provide all information as required within the Contract Documents. The bidder is required to bid on all items of every schedule or as otherwise detailed in the Instructions to Bidders.

Bids may be held by Casper/Natrona County International Airport Board of Trustees for a period not to exceed 120 calendar days from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of evaluating bids prior to award of contract.

The right is reserved, as Casper/Natrona County International Airport Board of Trustees may require, to reject any and all bids and to waive any informality in the bids received.

**Bid Bond.** Guarantee will be required with each bid as a certified check on a solvent bank or a Bid Bond in the amount of five (5) % of the total amount of the bid, made payable to the Casper/Natrona County International Airport Board of Trustees.

**Performance & Payment Bond.** The successful bidder will be required to furnish separate performance and payment bonds each in an amount equal to 100% of the contract price.

**Airport and Airway Improvement Act of 1982 as Amended.** In accordance with the Davis-Bacon Act, as amended, the Contractor will be required to comply with the wage and labor requirements and to pay minimum wages in accordance with the schedule of wage rates established by the United States Department of Labor.

**Equal Employment Opportunity and Affirmative Action Requirement.** The proposed contract is under and subject to 41 CFR Part 60-4 and Executive Order 11246 of September 24, 1965, as amended, and to the equal opportunity clause and the Standard Federal Equal Employment Opportunity Construction Contract specifications including the goals and timetables for minority and female participation.

**Title VI Solicitation Notice:** The Casper/Natrona County International Airport Board of Trustees, in accordance with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (78 Stat. 252, 42 USC §§ 2000d to 2000d-4) and the Regulations, hereby notifies all bidders or offerors that it will affirmatively ensure that any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises will be afforded full and fair opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, or national origin in consideration for an award.

**DBE Requirement.**

**Information submitted as a matter of bidder responsibility:**

The requirements of 49 CFR part 26 apply to this contract. It is the policy of the Casper/Natrona County International Airport Board of Trustees to practice nondiscrimination based on race, color, sex, or national origin in the award or performance of this contract. The Owner encourages participation by all firms qualifying under this solicitation regardless of business size or ownership.

Contractor shall provide a certified statement signed by the subcontractors, indicating actual amounts paid to the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) subcontractors and/or suppliers that were used on the project through race neutral means.

**Buy American Preference.** The Contractor agrees to comply with 49 USC § 50101, which provides that Federal funds may not be obligated unless all steel and manufactured goods used in AIP funded projects are produced in the United States, unless the Federal Aviation Administration has issued a waiver for the product; the product is listed as an Excepted Article, Material Or Supply in Federal Acquisition Regulation subpart 25.108; or is included in the FAA Nationwide Buy American Waivers Issued list.

A bidder or offeror must complete and submit the Buy America certification included herein with their bid or offer. The Owner will reject as nonresponsive any bid or offer that does not include a completed Certificate of Buy American Compliance.

**Certification of Offeror/Bidder Regarding Debarment.** By submitting a bid/proposal under this solicitation, the bidder or offeror certifies that neither it nor its principals are presently debarred or suspended by any Federal department or agency from participation in this transaction.

**Winter Shutdown**

The Contractor shall anticipate a winter shutdown for the project and construction activities resuming the following Spring. Timing of the winter shutdown may be at the discretion of the Contractor. However, the Engineer reserves the right to determine the timing of the shutdown if, in the opinion of the Engineer, further work will be detrimental to the quality of items being completed and constructed. The Contractor will be required to protect and maintain their work to the satisfaction of the Engineer throughout the winter shutdown. Any associated costs with the winter shutdown shall be considered incidental to mobilization.
